GUIDELINES

Description	<p>Juried art exhibition tied to the Timberlake community located in Lakeland School District's northern boundaries, including Spirit Lake, Athol, Bayview, Twin Lakes and surrounding areas. You will be asked to share on your application how you are connected to the Timberlake community.</p> <p>NEW this year is the inclusion of Timberlake Junior High School, grades 7-8.</p>
Eligibility	<p>Open to persons working within, living within or connected to Timberlake community in some way.</p> <p>Timberlake Creates JURIED categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students Junior High School, attending Timberlake Junior High School, homeschool, private or equivalent • Students High School, attending Timberlake, Mountain View, homeschool, private or equivalent • Adult Community • Adult Professional, meaning persons who work with art on a regular basis, have extensive formal training or experience, or make a living—in goods, trade or dollars—through their artwork
Exhibition Location	<p>Opening reception Timberlake High School, FRIDAY May 15, 2008. Time and details to be announced.</p> <p>Participating gallery locations throughout Spirit Lake, Idaho. Locations vary.</p>
Awards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Every participant will receive a certificate of entry, presented at the opening reception or mailed to entrants. • Selected artists' work will be exhibited throughout Spirit Lake and included in all publicity. • Cash prizes for 1st place (through the generous donation of Inland Northwest Bank), and 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded in all categories. Previous year's prizes have reached upwards of several hundred dollars for 1st place.

GUIDELINES—REQUIREMENTS continued

Requirements-- Artwork	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Any two-dimensional (flat) media, original art that can be hung or propped against a wall.• Not to exceed 36” in any one direction, including frame. <i>Exhibition space is limited.</i>• Artwork <u>does not</u> need to be framed to enter.• However, if selected, artwork must be suitably prepared for exhibition (framed or matted) by the time exhibition starts.• Artist is responsible for transport of artwork to/from Timberlake High School. Do not drop off art at the school unless notified to do so. We are unable to hold any artwork except that which has been selected for the exhibition.• Artwork will NOT be insured during any part of exhibition; artists concerned about maintenance or insurance of their artwork are encouraged to self-insure work.
Requirements— Images	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Good quality digital images are required.• Titled with artist’s LASTNAME followed by an underline and number. <i>Example: Smith_01.jpg.</i> Images should correspond to REGISTRATION FORMS, below.• JPG, TIF or similar files only. Do not submit JPG file within a Word, PowerPoint, etc., just the art image(s).• You may submit 1, 2 or 3 images. None or all may be selected.
